


# dark matter composites Itd

2. Redbourn is a village location, local to the main towns of Harpenden, St Albans, Hemel Hempstead and Luton, all of which are linked via road and are served by taxis, bus and rail networks



### **LOCAL DIRECTIONS**

### **B487 from Hemel Hempstead:**

 Pass under the M1 and turn left into Redbourn at the next roundabout

#### A5183 from St Albans:

 At the end of the A5183 from St Albans, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit at the roundabout straight into Redbourn

#### **B487 from Harpenden:**

- At the bottom of the B487 hill, turn left at the roundabout (1<sup>st</sup> exit)
- At the next roundabout turn right (3<sup>rd</sup> exit) into Redbourn

#### M1 Junction 9:


- Head southbound on the A5183
- At the first roundabout go straight on (2<sup>nd</sup> exit)
- At the second roundabout turn right (3<sup>rd</sup> exit) into Redbourn

#### ALL:

 Entering Redbourn, you pass under an old railway bridge and give way at a road restriction. Turn right into the industrial estate just after the restriction.

#### Parking:

 There is limited parking on site. Additional on street parking is available between the A5183 roundabout and the entrance of the Industrial Estate (Between Medivet and Jennis Sandwich shop).


